Directions to Hospital	Turn left out of Candytuft Way onto Greenwood Way. Follow Greenwood Way into Sir Frank Williams Avenue. Turn left at the traffic lights onto the A4130. At the Milton Interchange roundabout, take the A34 North towards Oxford. Exit the A34 at the Oxford Ring Road/Southern Bypass. Turn left at the next roundabout onto the A4144. Turn right onto Weirs Lane/B4495 and left at the end of the road onto Iffley Road/A4158. At the roundabout, take the 3 rd exit onto St Clements St./A420. Turn left at the mini roundabout onto Marston Road/B4150. After 0.8 miles, turn right at the mini roundabout onto Jack Straws Lane and straight into Staunton Road. Turn left onto Headley Way/B4495 and then immediately right at the roundabout into the hospital approach.
